The M.A. program in Holocaust Studies at the University of Haifa is a first-rate academic program aimed at training Holocaust scholars and providing them with a well-rounded, multidisciplinary curriculum that includes essential languages, diverse methodologies and research skills, courses in history, social psychology, anthropology, literature, international law and genocide.

A unique feature of the program is cooperation with museums and archives of the Holocaust period in Israel and abroad. Student will conduct guided research in these archives which will be based on primary sources and acquire expertise in writing academic research papers. Outstanding students who achieve success in the program will be considered for Ph.D. candidacy.

The program –carried out in English – offers the opportunity for students to spend 3 semesters in Israel, to meet and study with people from all over the world.
