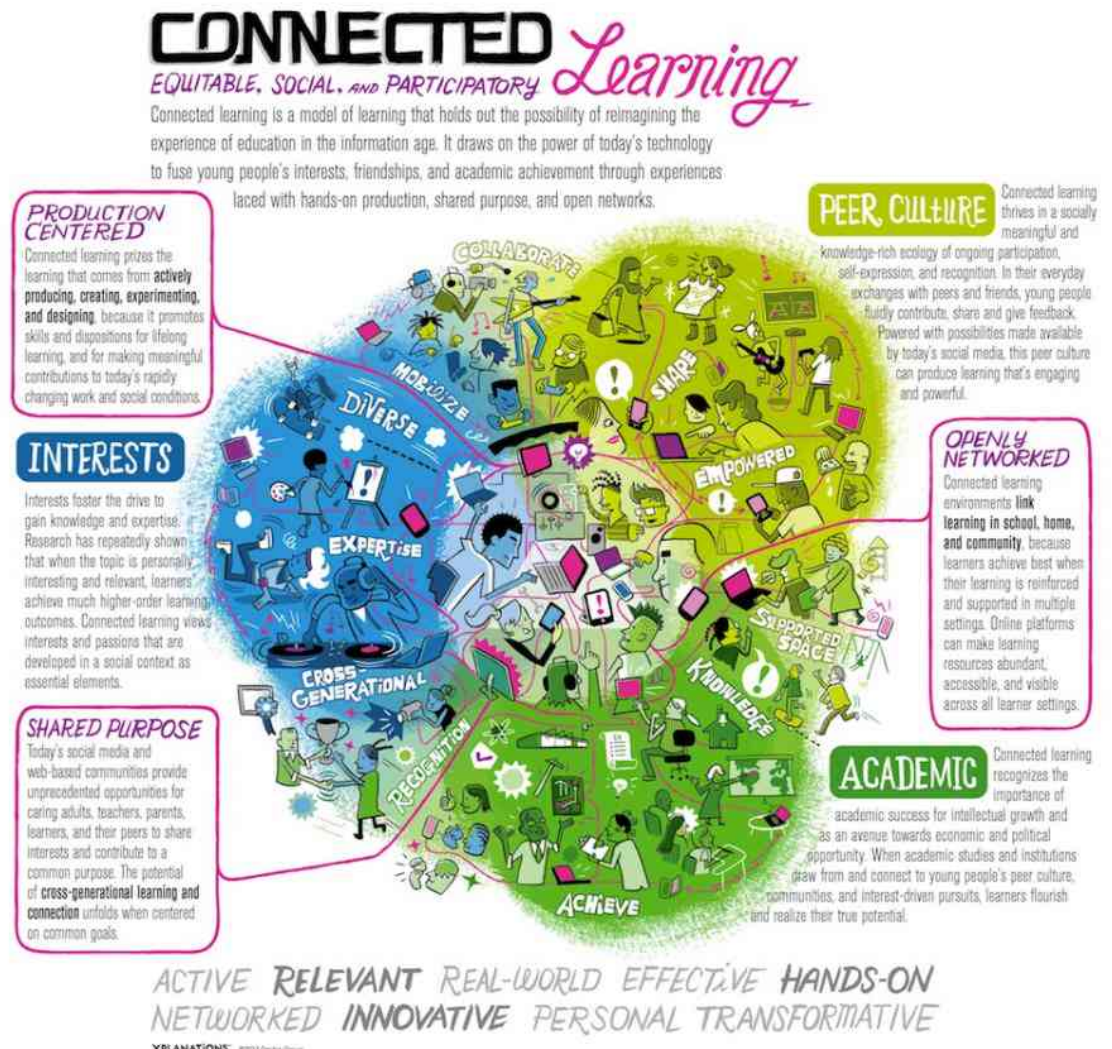


# Minnesota Writing Project's Fall Workshop: Teaching with Connected Learning
